
## THE MARESME

Maresme = from latin *maritima*, same meaning as Catalan, "belonging to the sea"

This is the name of this county, located north-east of Barcelona, with a complex morphology, consisting of the Serralada Litoral mountain range, the hills and the coastal area. The torrents of the Maresme, perpendicular to the coastal ridge, often follow fault lines and collect small tributaries along the descent. They have always represented a very significant feature of the natural landscape and of the identity of this county; they also perform important hydrological, ecological and social functions. The system of large parks and natural areas is articulated following the various massifs that constitute the Coastal Cordillera.

The new Metropolitan Territorial Plan of Barcelona foresees, with regard to transport infrastructures, the displacement of the suburban line Barcelona-Mataró in the hinterland, in order to increase its territorial coverage on some urban settlements that have been extended inland, improving the environmental quality of the coastal facade of the

In the Lower Maresme, considering the municipality of Vilassar de Mar as the project area, it is mainly a question of acting on the coast to overcome the impact it generates on the relationship between city and sea. It is precisely starting from this consideration that the proposal inserts the waterfront project within a broader system that considers the coastal front as a pivotal meeting point not only with the city but also with the entire landscape.
