## The agroecological design toolbox

The design tools are represented here through small axonometries that give the idea of the physicality of possible interventions. In addition to reading the table through the design categories, it is also possible to observe it through the colours. In fact, *blue and green represent the design tools that involve natural elements* (such as reforestation, open fields, multi-species rows, etc.). *Yellow*, on the other hand, represents elements that relate to agricultural production and areas of research and education in this field.

As can be seen, agroecology leads to synergistic links between the two components, which is why many design tools feature both colours.
