

INTRODUCTION

The Model was erected on the outskirts of Barcelona in 1904, and conceived with the aim of being an exemplary prison by then. The prison occupied two blocks of the Eixample and launched an innovative architectural design in the form of a panopticon: starting from a polygonal central body - where the vigilantes were located - six galleries were born radially.

Within more than 100 years, La Model was served as a prison and went through many historical moments. After its closure in 2017, how to integrate the old prison into the city was under the discussion. Following its closure and transfer to the City Council, a new stage of opening is now beginning. The recovery of this unique space for the city and for public use is a unique opportunity for Barcelona, an opportunity for urban regeneration that will leave behind more than a century of hermeticism. Today, La Model is going to be a socio-cultural and multipurpose facility, open to everyone, which hosts various temporary activities to start this integration of the prison in the city.




Ildefons Cerda and the Plan for Eixample

Ildefons Cerdà was a Spanish urban planner and engineer who designed the 19th-century "extension" of Barcelona called the Eixample. Because of his extensive theoretical and practical work, he is considered the founder of modern town planning as a discipline, having coined the new word "urbanization".

The evolution of Barcelona's wall


An extended wall was built in 1260, and then in the **15th century**, the wall was expanded again to encompass the new Raval neighborhood. The part of the plain outside the wall was used for agriculture to provision the city.


In 1714, Philip V built a fortress citadel forbid Barcelona to grow beyond its medieval walls. By the middle of the **19th century**, population density was the highest in Spain, working conditions were miserable, sewage was out of control, water was dirty, and the city was struck by a series of cholera epidemics and riots.

By 1854, when the Spanish government finally gave permission to take the wall down, it was one of the most hated structures in Europe. Townspeople immediately went at it with crowbars and pickaxes; it took **12 years** to completely remove it.






The pattern of regular rectilinear blocks (exactly 113.3 by 113.3 meters, for 12,370 square meters, with at least 800 square meters for gardens).



Espanya Industrial Park










A reclaimed land in 1980s to change it from an abandoned industrial area in to a public park.






Plan of Jeremy Bentham's panopticon prison, drawn by Willey Reveley in 1791

Later addition

In 1882 Salvador Vinyals and Josep Domènech i Estapà began to propose a first preliminary project that was to serve as the model for the new Barcelona penitentiary.

On June 3, 1888, the official start of works took place. In 1890, with the works already started, a series of modifications were made to the project.

After the inauguration (1904), the construction of the building was completed in 1908, and which greatly changed its final design with respect to the original preliminary design.

As can be seen in the image, the prison has undergone numerous actions that have involved both the addition of new buildings and the transformation of the original buildings.


The panopticon is a type of institutional building and a system of control designed by the English philosopher and social theorist Jeremy Bentham in the 18th century.


The word panopticon derives from the Greek word for "all seeing" – panoptes. The concept of the design is to allow all prisoners of an institution to be observed by a single security guard, without the inmates being able to tell whether they are being watched.

In 1812 persistent problems with Newgate Prison and other London prisons prompted the British government to fund the construction of a prison in Millbank. Based on Bentham's panopticon plans, the National Penitentiary opened in 1821.


In 1975 Foucault used the panopticon as metaphor for the modern disciplinary society in Discipline and Punish. He argued that the disciplinary society had emerged in the 18th century and that discipline are techniques for assuring the ordering of human complexities, with the ultimate aim of docility and utility in the system.
