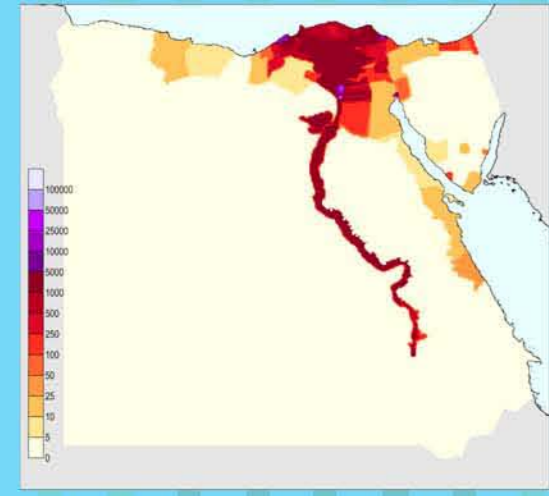


The River

From Memphis to Thebes

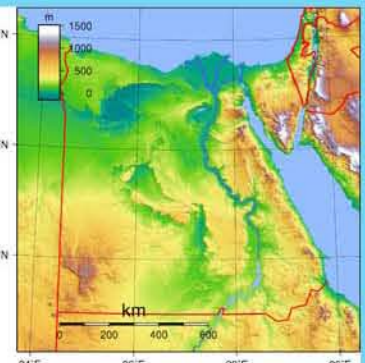


The Egyptian capital was always in the Nile valley except at the times of the Greek and the Roman.

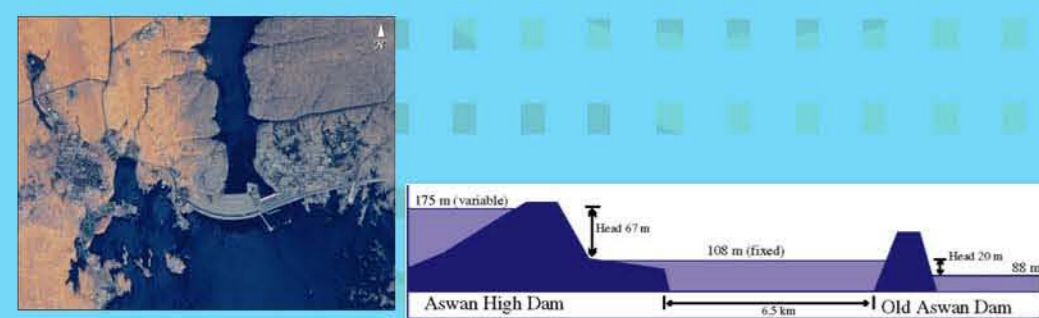
