

Paradise streams:
 Favareh or Shorn (Water jets):
 water jets in Persian gardens are the elements that sprinkle the water with high pressure into the air and cool down the air. to create water jets in gardens sometimes they would built a water tank higher than the ground level and using the pressure due to the difference in the height, the water would be sprinkled in the air.
 Juy (Water channels):
 to circulate the water through the garden and creating a better view of water, Juys are used which are water channels with the depth of 30 cm and width of 80 cm which would run through the whole garden and in specified distances they would have water jets.
