One of the problem of tourism in the Valleys is the traffic caused by the lack of adequate public transport, then the next analysis take to account the old infrastructural system existing and the new public projects.

What is more important is also the presence of the cycle paths, because the main touristic attractiveness is the natural aspect in these areas. In fact the connection systems of cycle routes from Bergamo to Ponte Nossa and some pieces from Clusone to Valbondione are popular.

The project aims to create an intermodal connection in support of hiking and cycle routes.

The strategy want to elaborate a system to stimulate a new type of tourism, mainly based on nature.

The railway transportation should support new cycle paths directly connected to each other.

In addition, by a better organization of intermodal travel routes, e. g. exploiting the interconnection between hiking, cycling or cultural paths; the towns could born again, through the regeneration of relevant places and the subsequent opening of new services.
