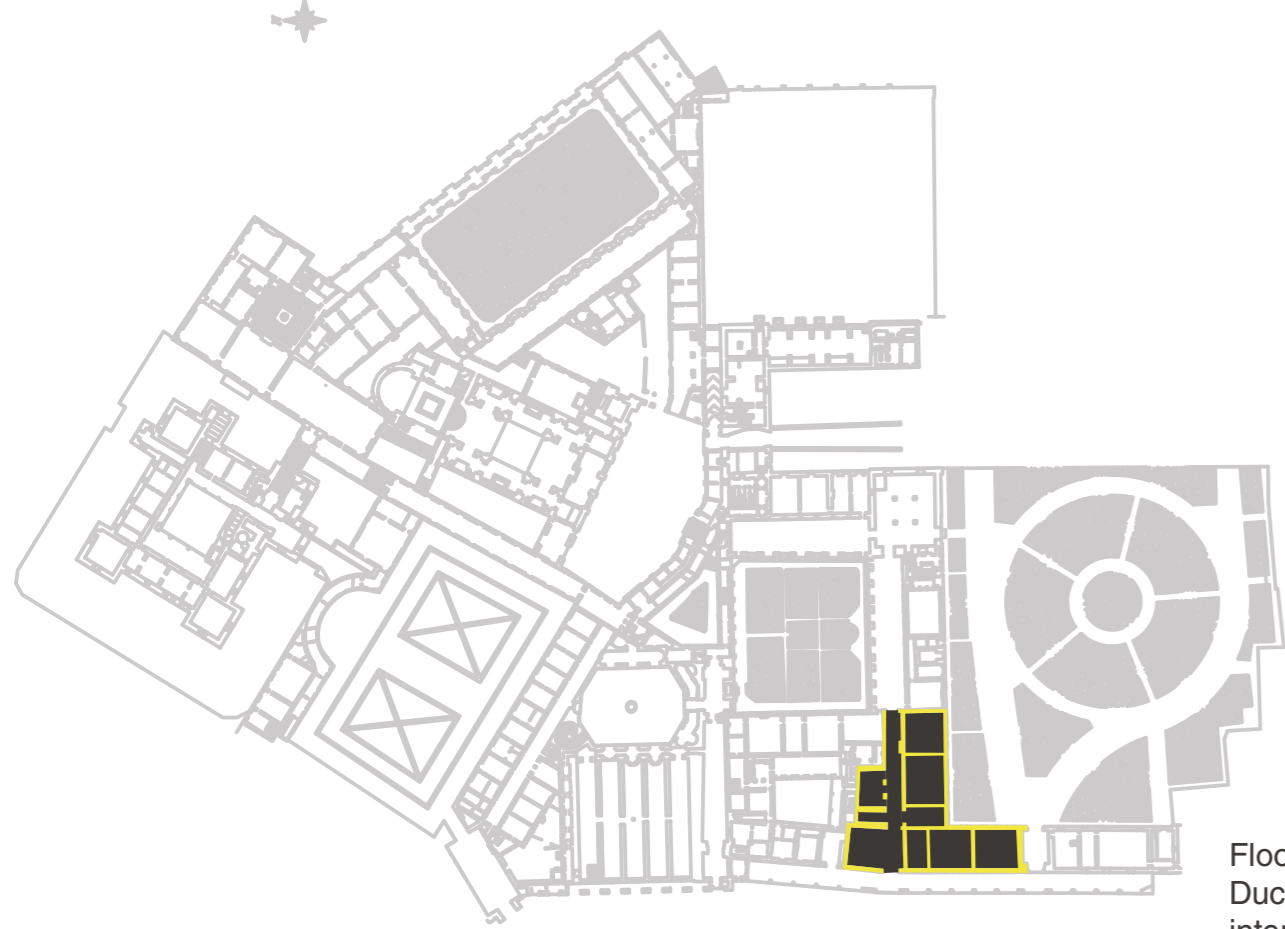
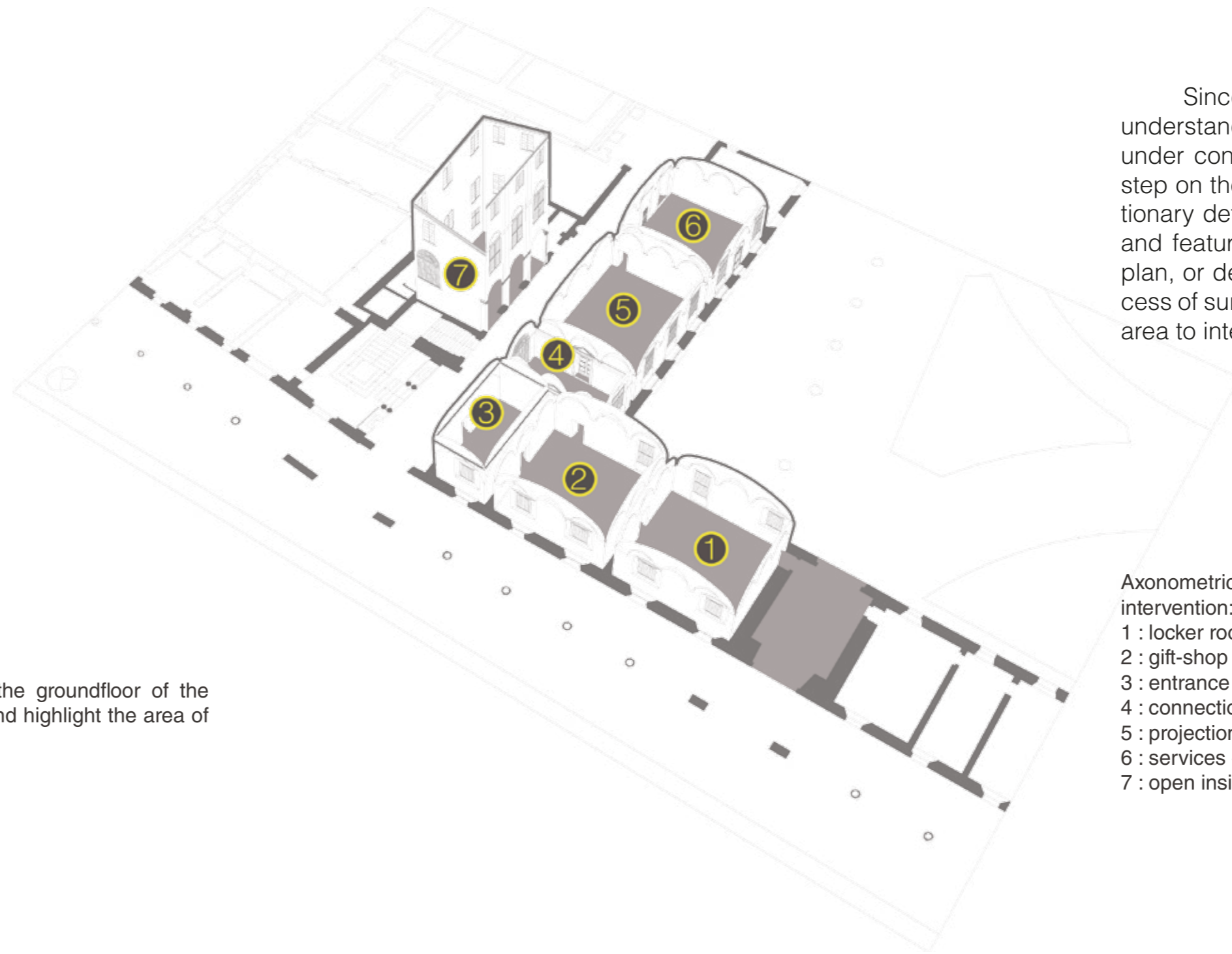


# CHAPTER 2 : ANALYSIS OF THE PROJECT AREA

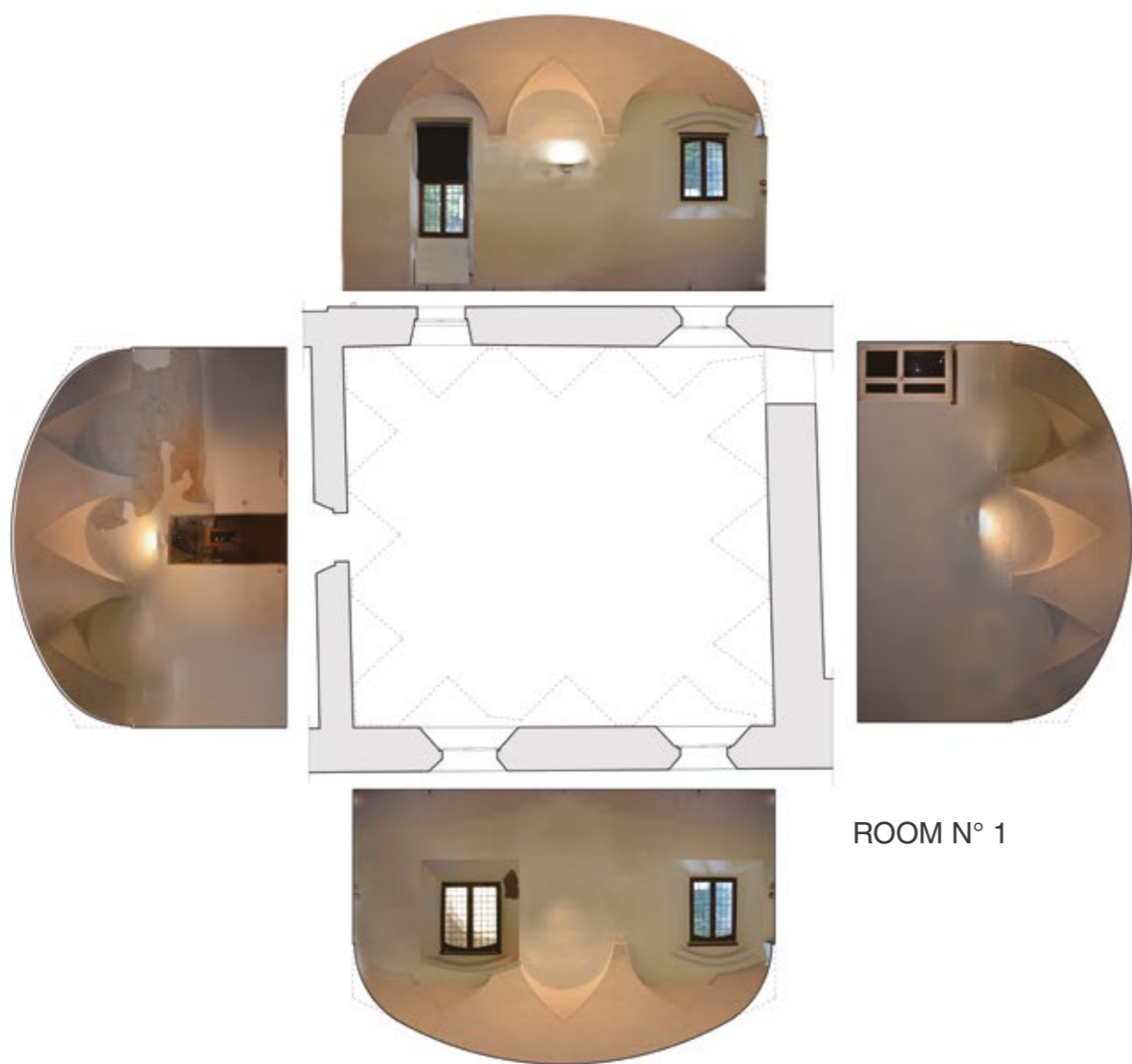


Floor plan the the groundfloor of the Ducal Palace, and highlight the area of intervention.

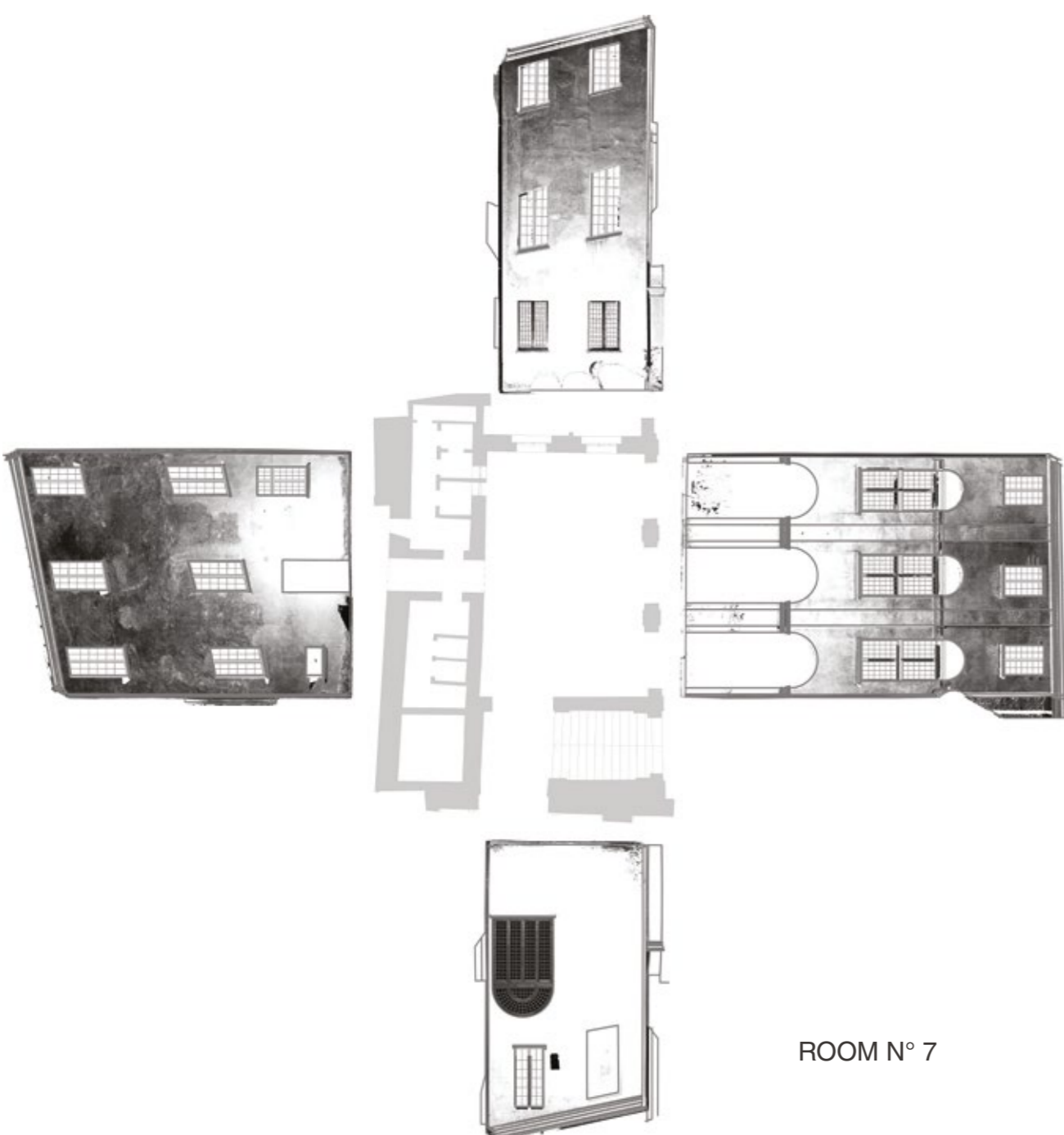

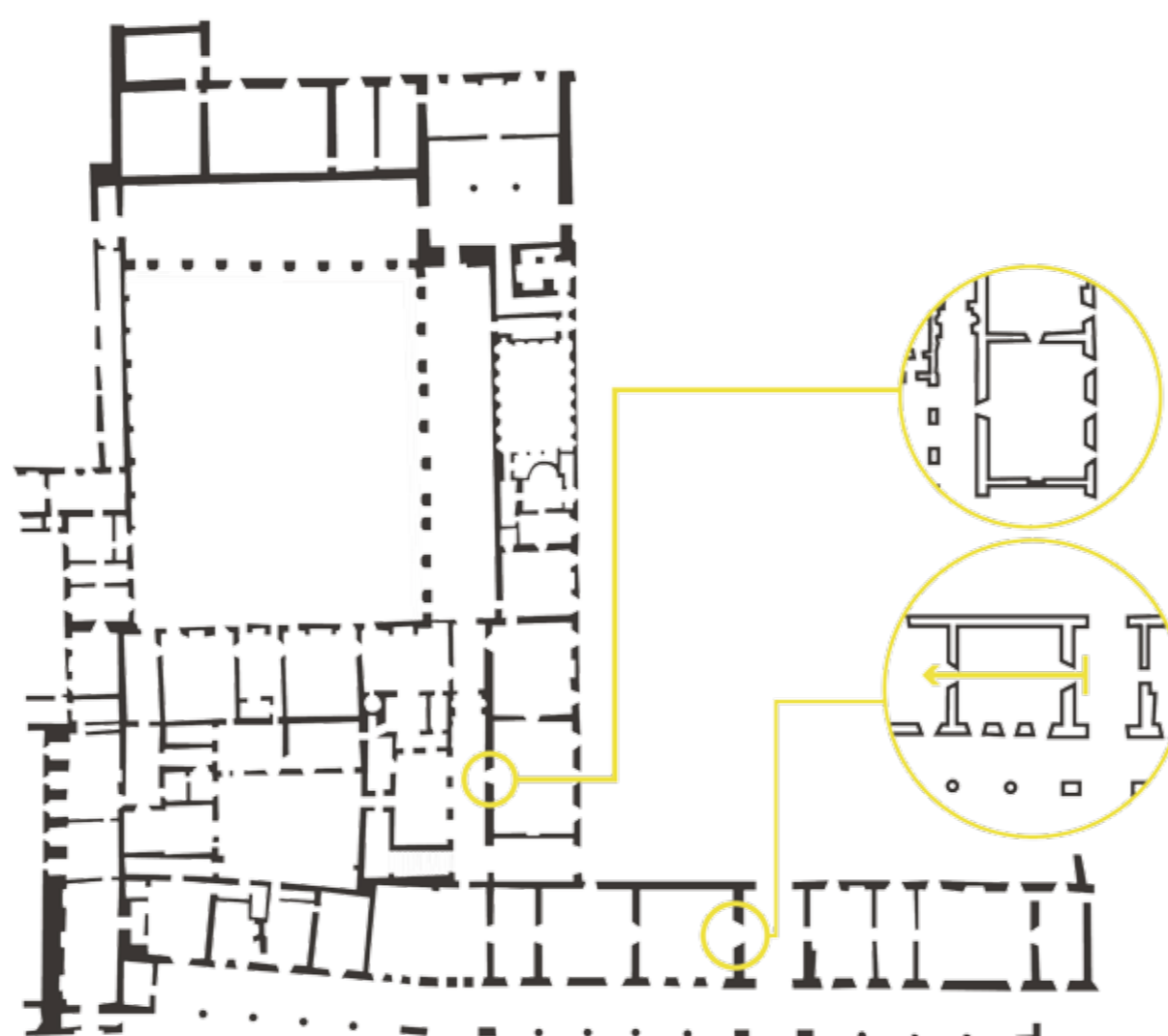

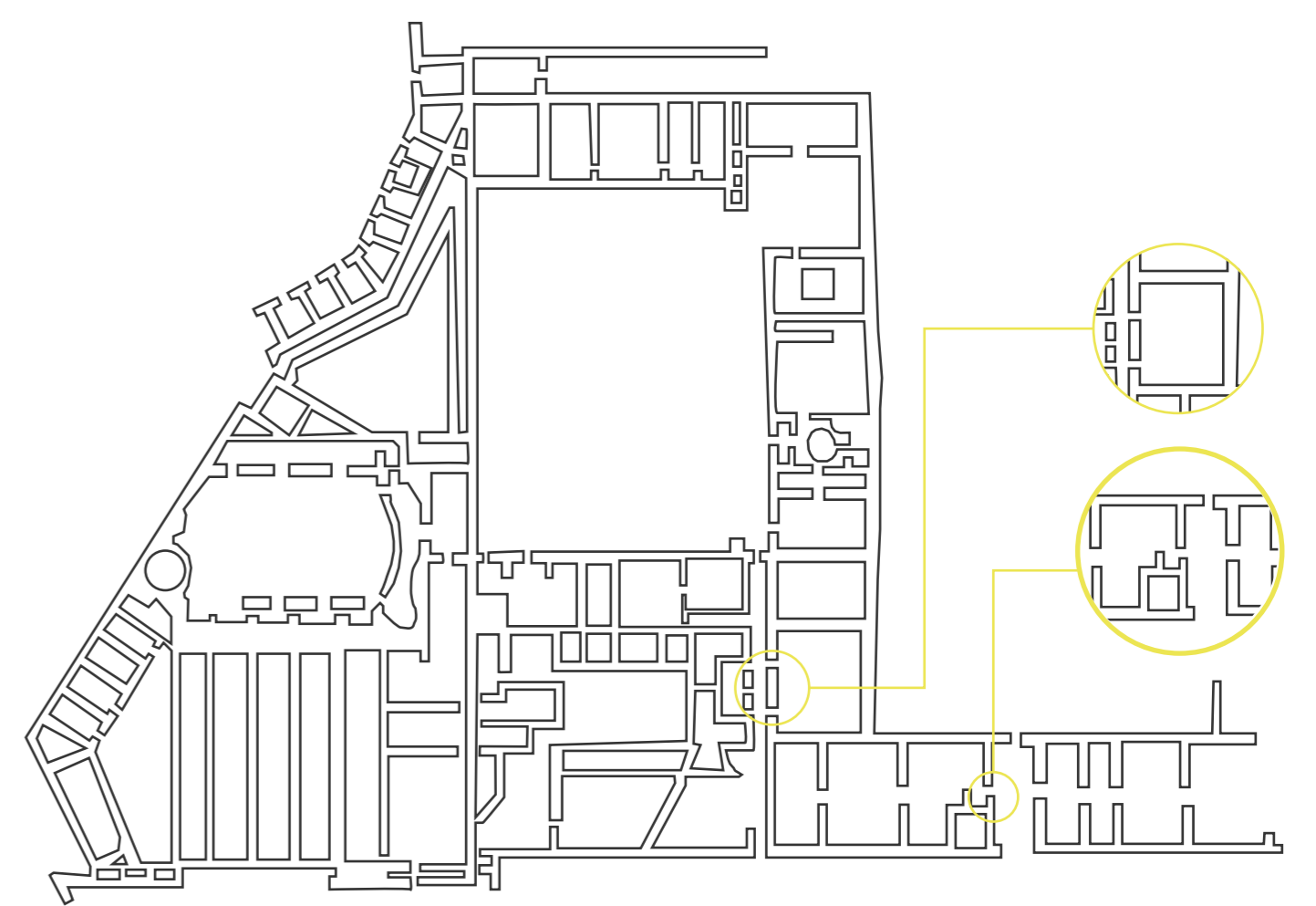
