



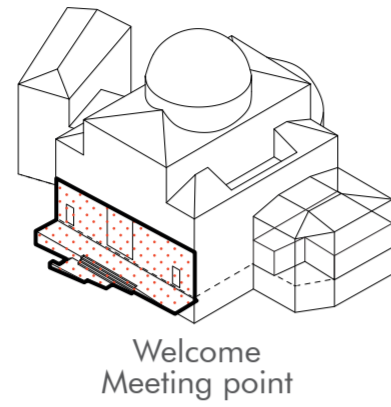
ORATORIO

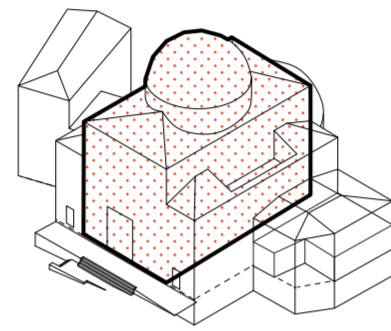

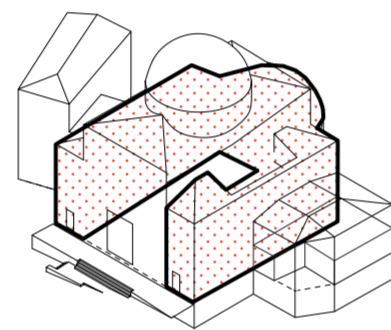
MAP OF ACTIVITIES



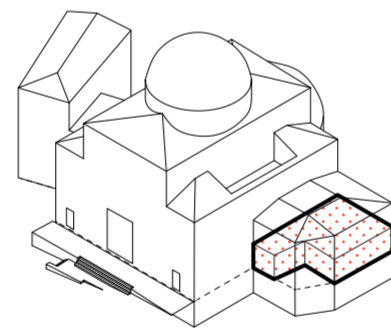
Welcome Meeting point



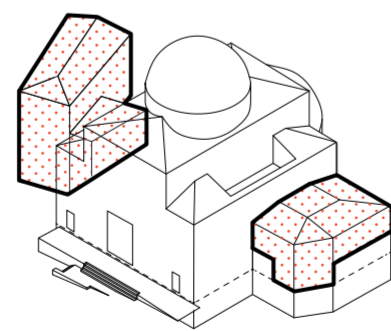
Social market Stage for marginal art expression



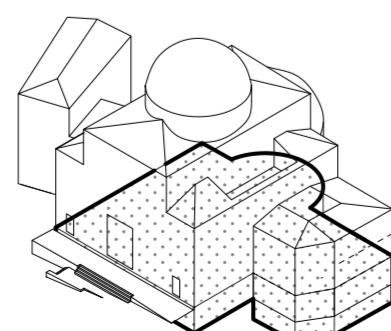
Cultural path
