
The abandoned farm and animals shed is turned into a meeting place and research centre

The new farmers' market and research area is conceived as a place for meeting and sharing, a place where people study but at the same time produce and sell. In line with the objectives of the Milan FoodPolicy, this new centre is configured as a hub for Milan's agricultural community. A central square hosts equipped open spaces, shaded by elms and maples. in front of the square, a semi-covered space for events. Functions: 1- Research center 2- Covered Agri Market 3- Covered meting and evenes 4- The new courtyard of the cascina 5 - Parking lots 6- Intercropping 7- Flowered meadow 8 - The debris hills, renaturalized 9- Abandoned silos as a new threshold-entry


