

Alternative proposals

What to connect:

Replacing the Visconteo bridge will require to restablish the connection between Valeggio and Monte Borghetto, to ensure this action any cross will require to pass the three water elements that interrupt the connection, the Seriola canal, Virgilio canal and the Mincio river.



- 1 The first alternative takes on mind the re utilization of the existing system of bridges and roads, the distance of the deviation is of 3,1km
- 2 The second alternative distances from the Visconteo bridge, aligning with an existent axis, this alternative will require of the construction of new bridges, the distance of the deviation is of 2,62km
- 3 The third alternative takes on mind the crossing of all water elements on just one axis on the location where the watercourses narrow, the deviation distance of this alternative is of 3,7km


